Program Descriptions:

Homemaking: This service includes light housekeeping; dusting, mopping, vacuuming, cleaning bathrooms and kitchens, making beds, maintaining a safe home environment, meal preparation, laundry, social and emotional support. This much needed service allows our seniors to live in their homes independently.

Personal Care: Helping those with personal care activities; bathing, dressing, shaving and more. This service is provided by trained direct care staff and allows our seniors to stay independent in their own homes.

In-Home Respite: The In-Home Respite Program will provide a trained direct care worker to go to an individual's home to provide respite services. This service allows the caregiver the time and security to run errands, shop, and visit or just relax. The COA staff will provide companionship and care, for those in need, in the familiar environment of their own home.

DayBreak ADC: Our Adult Day Center provides a safe, positive and caring environment for frail seniors that do not need 24 hour skilled care. Set in a family style environment, Daybreak offers, caring supervision, activities, meals and companionship.

Foot Care: Our nurses provide much needed foot care at three monthly clinics, in office and private in home appointments.

MMAPS: We offer certified counselors that provide assistance and information regarding Medicare and Medicaid, so our seniors can make informed decisions regarding prescription plans, Medicare D, and correspondence received from Medicare or Medicaid. They also can help fill out applications for assistance from other programs or just understanding correspondence they may receive from other agencies or companies.

Project Fresh: Provides free coupons worth \$20 for those that qualify financially for fresh produce from local farmers markets and other produce markets.

Snow Removal: A program to help those that have no other assistance to keep their driveways and approaches cleared during the northern Michigan winters, thus promoting independence for our Wexford County Seniors.

Newsletter: Mailed out to over 600 seniors in Wexford County on a bi-monthly basis. The newsletter is full of information on Health & Wellness, Medicare, Activities, Events, and other information important to our seniors.

Senior Educational Programs: Bringing in speakers to our communities to discuss aging topics, scams, healthy lifestyles and care giving solutions.

Other: The Council on Aging provides so many other services that are not a part of the main service programs such as Incontinence Supplies, Ensure, and Paper and Personal products. These items are usually donated to the agency and we make sure they go to seniors in the most need. We also partner with other agencies in providing special moments to our most isolated and home bound seniors such as Project Christmas, a handmade Birthday Card for every COA Client, a white memorial rose for clients that pass on, just to name a few.
